

- All classroom teachers have a positive reinforcement system in place to reward positive choices, while ensuring reteaching is taking place for unwanted behaviors using Class Dojo as a tool.
- Social-Emotional Learning is an important part of our daily learning at Howard. This year, we have adopted an additional SEL program-it is called TRAILS through the University of Michigan. This is being integrated into school social worker sessions for students who receive this service. Please know that our School Social Worker, Ms. Katharine Johnston, is available for support.
