How To Camp At Home

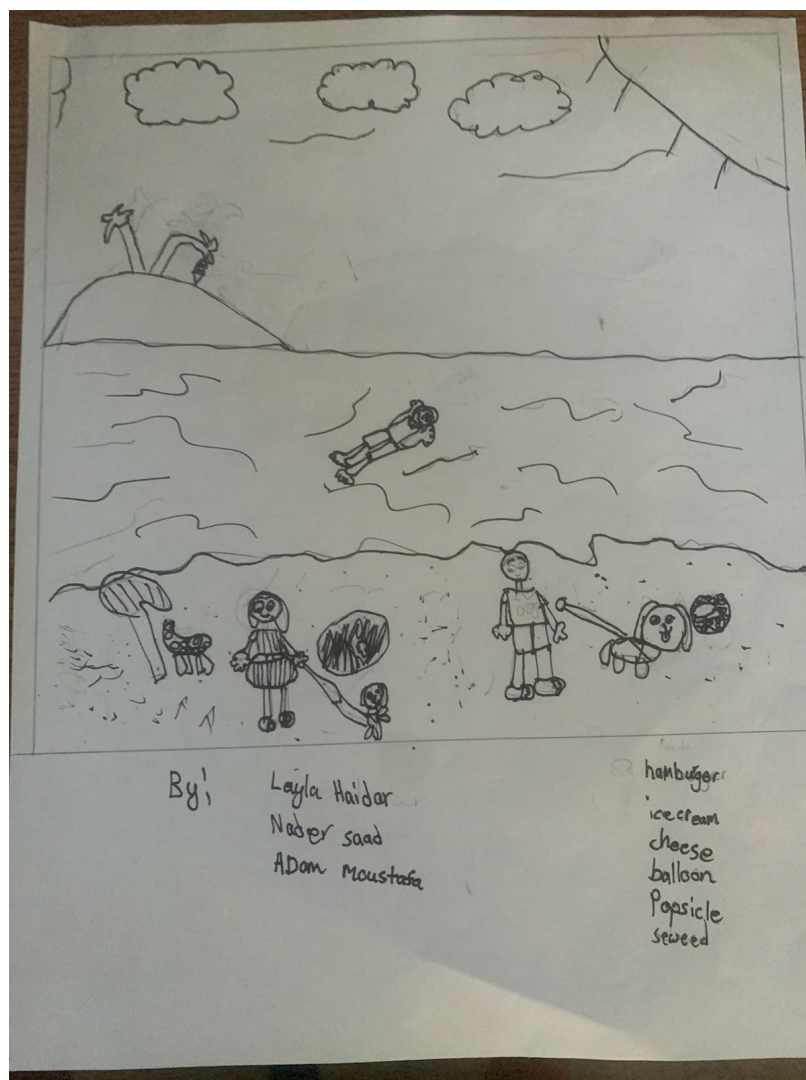
